May 5, 2010... **Karen Kain**, Artistic Director of The National Ballet of Canada, today announced the principal casting for *Onegin*, which opens on June 19, 2010 at the Four Seasons Centre for the Performing Arts and features glorious new sets and costumes by **Santo Loquasto**.

Principal Dancer **Jiří Jelinek** will dance the role of Eugene Onegin on opening night, June 19, at 7:30 pm. One of Mr. Jelinek's most acclaimed roles, he has performed in *Onegin* with companies throughout Europe and Asia. He will dance with Principal Dancer **Xiao Nan Yu** as Tatiana.

The opening night cast will also feature Principal Dancers **Guillaume Côté** as Lensky, **Heather Ogden** as Olga, who makes her debut in the role, and a special appearance by Artist-in-Residence **Rex Harrington** as Prince Gremin.

Principal Dancer **Sonia Rodriguez** makes her debut as Tatiana and on June 22, the National Ballet celebrates her 20th anniversary performing with the company.

Principal Dancer **Guillaume Côté** and Corps de Ballet member **McGee Maddox** will make their debuts in the role of Eugene Onegin and Principal Dancer **Heather Ogden** makes debut as Tatiana. Other debuts include Principal Dancer **Piotr Stanczyk** and Second Soloist **Brett van Sickle** in the role of Lensky and Principal Dancer **Bridgett Zehr** and First Soloist **Jillian Vanstone** in the role of Olga. First Soloists **Jonathan Renna**, **Etienne Lavigne** and Second Soloist **Noah Long** also make their debuts as Prince Gremin.

Based on the narrative poem *Eugene Onegin* by **Alexander Pushkin**, *Onegin* is the story of unrequited love in the fated meeting of an innocent young girl with a cynical aristocrat. **John Cranko**'s 1965 ballet adaptation employs his distinctive choreographic style to capture the original story's emotional intensity, drama and tragedy with striking fidelity and perceptiveness. Along with his great versions of Shakespeare's *Romeo and Juliet* and *The Taming of the Shrew*, *Onegin* must rank as one of Cranko's – and modern ballet's – finest adaptations.

Onegin was staged for The National Ballet of Canada by Reid Anderson. Mr. Anderson was the Artistic Director of the National Ballet from 1989 until 1996 and is now Artistic Director of Stuttgart Ballet.
