February 17, 2010... **Karen Kain**, Artistic Director of The National Ballet of Canada, today announced the principal casting for *Swan Lake*, which opens on March 11, 2010 at the Four Seasons Centre for the Performing Arts.

Principal Dancer **Bridgett Zehr** makes her debut dancing the role of Odette/Odile. Making their debuts as Siegfried in **James Kudelka's** *Swan Lake* are Principal Dancers **Jiří Jelinek** and **Zdenek Konvalina**. First Soloist **Patrick Lavoie** and Second Soloist **Noah Long** make their debuts as Rothbart.

The opening night performance on March 11 will feature Principal Dancers **Heather Ogden** in the role of Odette/Odile and **Guillaume Côté** in the role of Siegfried. Principal Dancers **Sonia Rodriguez** and **Xiao Nan Yu** will also dance the role of Odette/Odile and Principal Dancer **Aleksandar Antonijevic** will perform the role of Siegfried.

One of the most revered ballets of all time, *Swan Lake* premiered over a century ago in Russia and remains a timeless classic, expressing a range of human emotions accented by Tchaikovsky's luminous score. Mr. Kudelka's 1999 version of the ballet adheres to its essentially fable-like nature but locates a new and rich trove of thematic implications in the material, re-thinking it for a contemporary audience. **Santo Loquasto's** superbly evocative sets and costumes provide the perfect setting for a work of arresting beauty.

The opening night pre-show Ballet Talk will be given by former Principal Dancer **Jennifer Fournier** 45 minutes prior to the curtain.
