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## Principal Dancer Aleksandar Antonijevic Explores the Human Shape at CONTACT May 5 to 15, 2011, Pimlico Design Gallery

Principal Dancer **Aleksandar Antonijevic**'s second photography exhibit, *Secrets of the Flesh*, opens on May 5, 2011 as part of CONTACT, Toronto's annual international photography festival. The exhibit runs until May 15 and is presented at the Pimlico Design Gallery in Toronto.

"In my photography, I continually explore the essence of shape and form. My many years as a dancer gives me an unique understanding of the effect body movement has on our senses," says Mr. Antonijevic.

Born in Serbia, Mr. Antonijevic has been a Principal Dancer with the National Ballet since 1995. Mr. Antonijevic has danced in most of the major works in the company's repertoire including principal roles in *Giselle*, *Onegin*, *Romeo and Juliet* and *The Sleeping Beauty*.

Mr. Antonijevic will next appear onstage in the North American premiere of *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* which opens the Summer Season on June 4, 2011.
